### A SAD HISTORY...

1. The Governor, the State of Maryland and the Montgomery County Council have known about the failed emergency communications system over the past 8-10 years. *And did nothing.* Until they tried to pull a fast one in Olney.
2. Olney was kept in the dark by the State and Montgomery County. We've been *stonewalled*. We've been *deceived*. We and the news media have been *misled*, accusing us of "NIMBYism."
3. While the technology crisis has brewed over the past 10 years, the Montgomery County Council has been AWOL.
4. The system outages are unrelated to the tower process. But our elected officials and government technology contractors point fingers at Olney people for the government system breakdowns.
5. The technocrats, our County Council and now Governor Hogan want, want, want the ICC/Ga Ave site and tell Olney people: "Go pound sand." The government contractors refused to consider Site 7 and other viable sites. They conjure up objections and excuses. Here's the truth: <http://bit.ly/2LFVTcH>
6. They don't care about the proposed Georgia Avenue tower *proximity to families, our health concerns and risk to property values.*
7. County Executive Marc Elrich and the Maryland State Highway Administrator agreed the process was unfair and pledged to Olney to look for other sites and to involve us in the process. Instead, Governor Hogan brushed aside the process, instead blaming Mr. Elrich for delaying the tower construction and insists on the Georgia Avenue/ICC site.
